Parental Notification Policy

Parents of students under the age of 21 will be notified when a student is found responsible for violating the Georgia Tech Student Policy on Alcohol and other Drugs when the following occurs:

- ? Student endangers themselves or others while under the influence of alcohol or other substances. Specific instances would include DUI, fighting, alcohol poisoning, and hospitalization.
- ? When an administrator determines that any future violations of the Institute's policy will most likely result in suspension from Georgia Tech.
- ? When an administrator determines that any future violation of the Institute's Policy will most likely result in removal from housing.

This policy amends the current Notification of Student Rights under FERPA in the Georgia Institute of Technology General Catalog.
